These have been converted to equivalent tonnes of carbon dioxide (tCO<sub>2e</sub>) using the published UK Government GHG Conversion Factors for Company Reporting for 2021.

## Summary Report for Financial Year Ending 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021

This carbon report provides the second-year reporting information for Claims Consortium Group in compliance with reporting requirements under The Companies (Directors' Report) and Limited Liability Partnerships (Energy and Carbon Report) Regulations 2018 to implement the UK government's policy on Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR).

During 2020 we have reduced emissions significantly due to working from home and embracing technologies such as zoom and teams. We have continued to use technologies even with our offices reopening. We aim for our impact to continue to be significantly less than prior years and will continue with remote meetings and not traveling unless necessary.
